


THE PRINCIPLE OF DARKNESS






























Tobias Ryuu was born in Kuala Lumpur in 1994. He graduated from The One Academy of Communications and Design in Selangor in 2016, majoring in Fine Arts. His education provided him with a solid foundation in various mediums. Ryuu's journey as a figurative artist began as a self-taught painter. In 2018, he furthered his artistic exploration with a focus on ancient painting techniques, following a brief apprenticeship in Florence, Italy. His research delved into the works of academic painters spanning from the sixteenth to the nineteenth century, including Caravaggio, Girodet, Géricault, Gleyre, Bouguereau, among others. Ryuu's artistic pursuit aims to bridge the past with the present and the foreseeable future.
